What is Bhava?

bhāva (भाव) - refers to one of the 12 houses of a horoscope. (literally can be translated as 'becoming', 'being', 'manner', 'sentiment', or 'emotion')

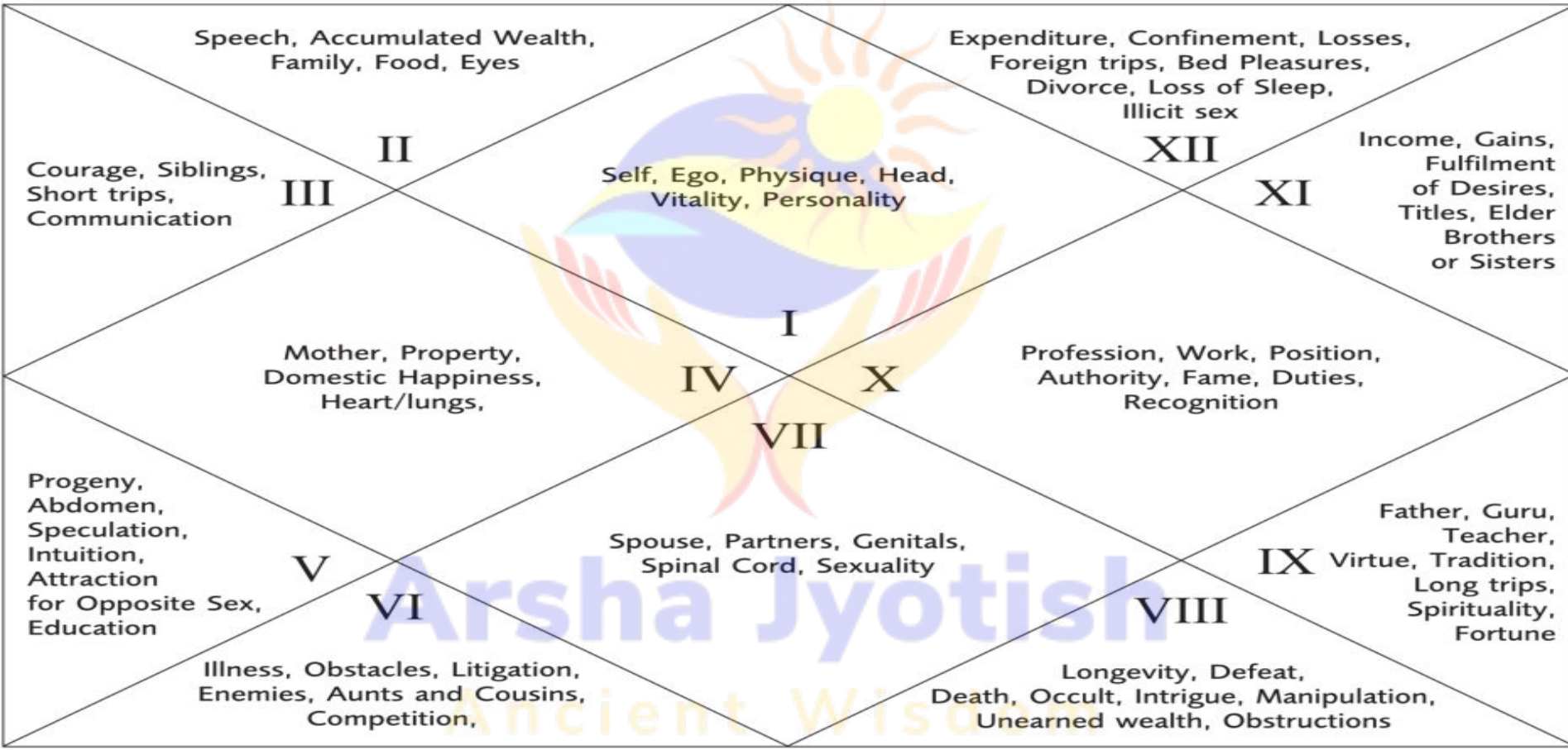
12 houses represents all the aspects of existence at the individual level

Understand 12 Houses, Plus what 9 planets, therein, signify.

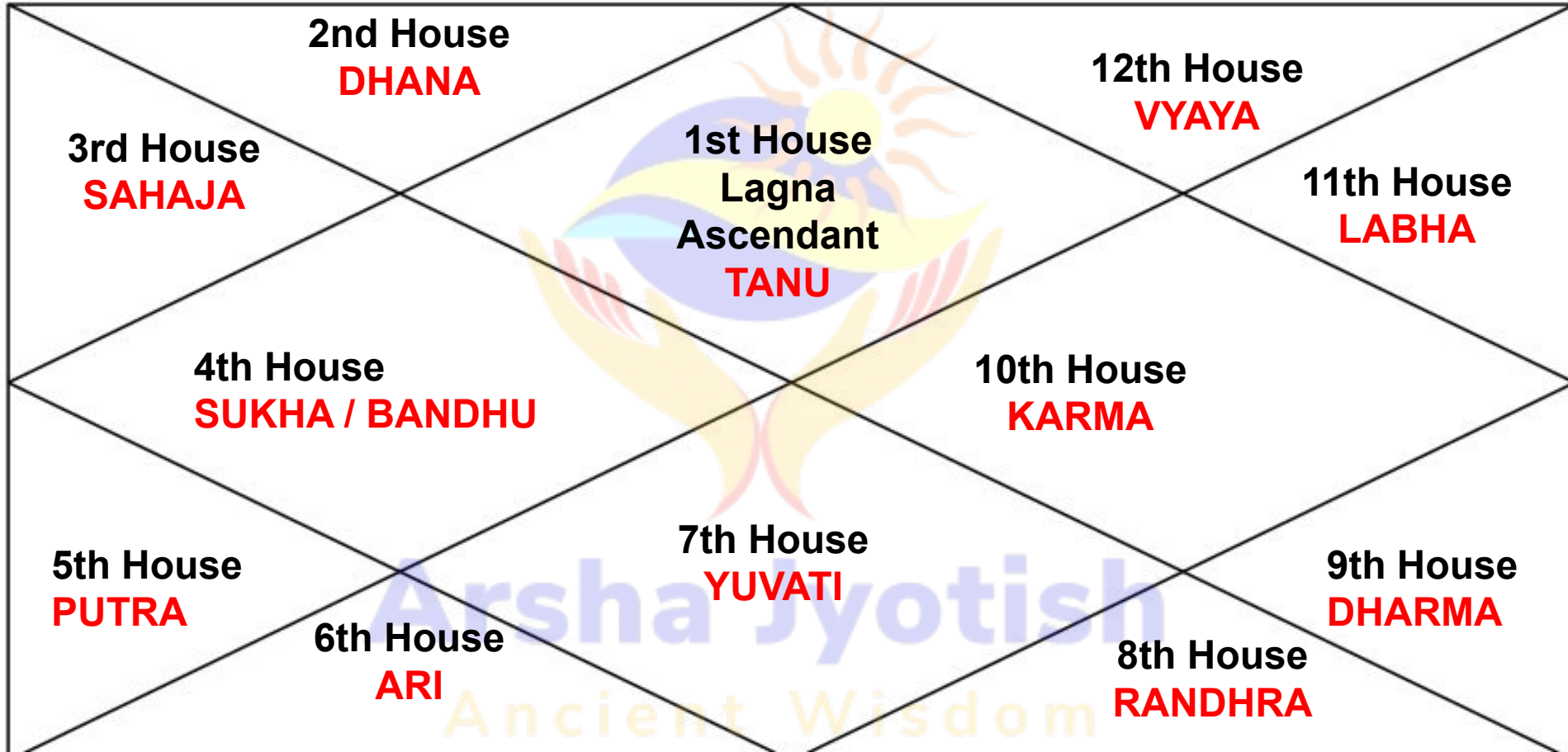
Understand interaction between planets and houses,
Plus a house signifiers must be considered
Plus integrated with dasa system

And other techniques
provides basis of accurate prediction.

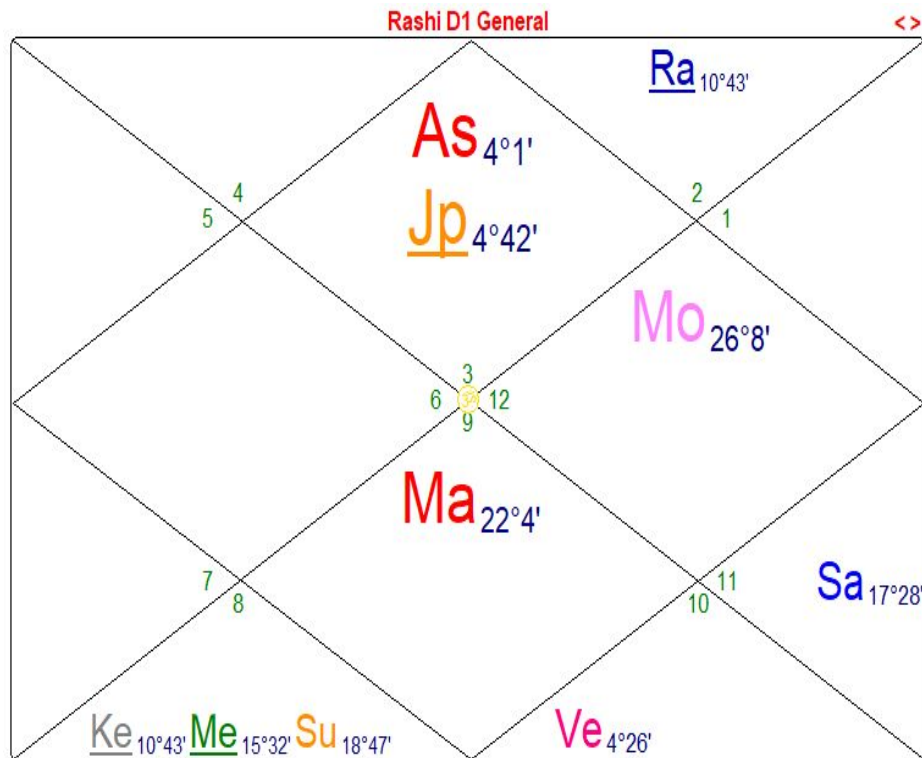

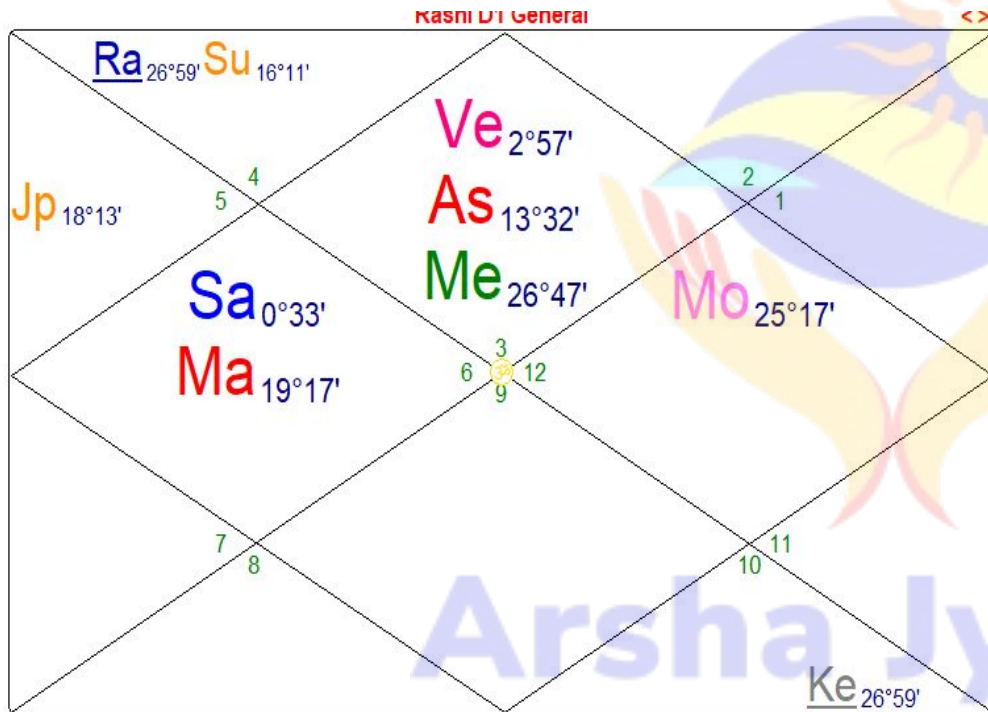

**WHICH HOUSES, DIFFERENT GROUP (SIMILAR
CHARACTERISTICS**

1. The ***Kendras*** (or Quadrants): Houses 1, 4, 7 and 10. These are highly significant houses.
2. The ***Panapharas*** (or Successant Houses): Houses 2, 5, 8 and 11.
3. The ***Apoklimas*** (or Cadent Houses): Houses 3, 6, 9 and 12.
4. The ***Trikonas*** (or Trines): Houses 1, 5 and 9. These are highly auspicious and, along with the Kendras, determine the health, wealth, status, dignity, rise and virtue of a native.
 - **The lagna**, being both a kendra and a trikona, is the most significant of all houses.
5. The ***Upachayas***: Houses 3, 6, 10 and 11. These houses indicate struggle, competition and material enhancement.
6. The ***Trika Houses***: Houses 6, 8 and 12. These are considered bad houses (Duhsthanas). They indicate debt, disease, loss, obstruction and misery.

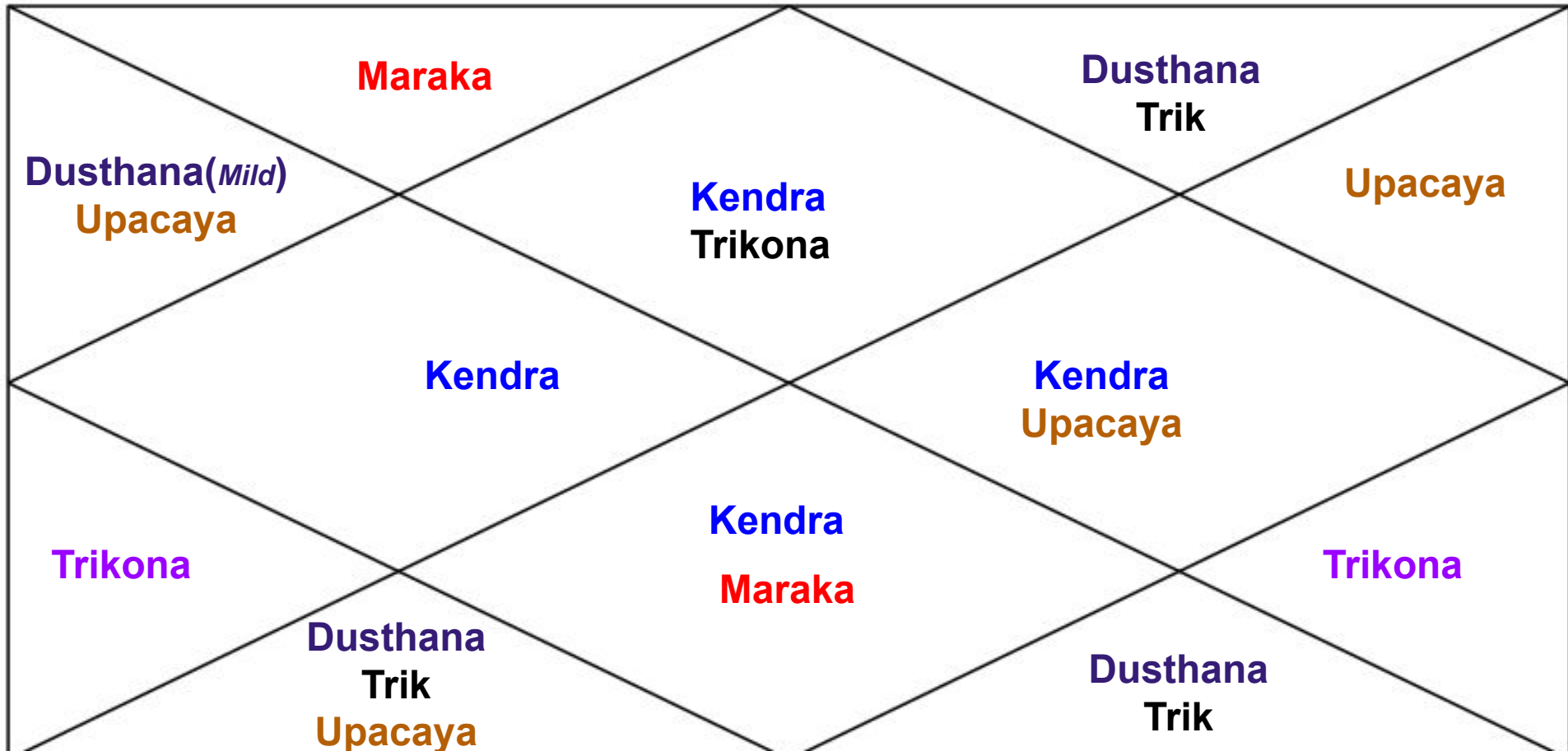

Dispositor

A dispositor is a planet that rules the sign that another planet is located in.

For example, if Venus is in Gemini, then Mercury is the dispositor of Venus.

Ruler / Lordship / Ownership - Lord or owner of a particular house

Position / Location - Location of a planet in a particular house

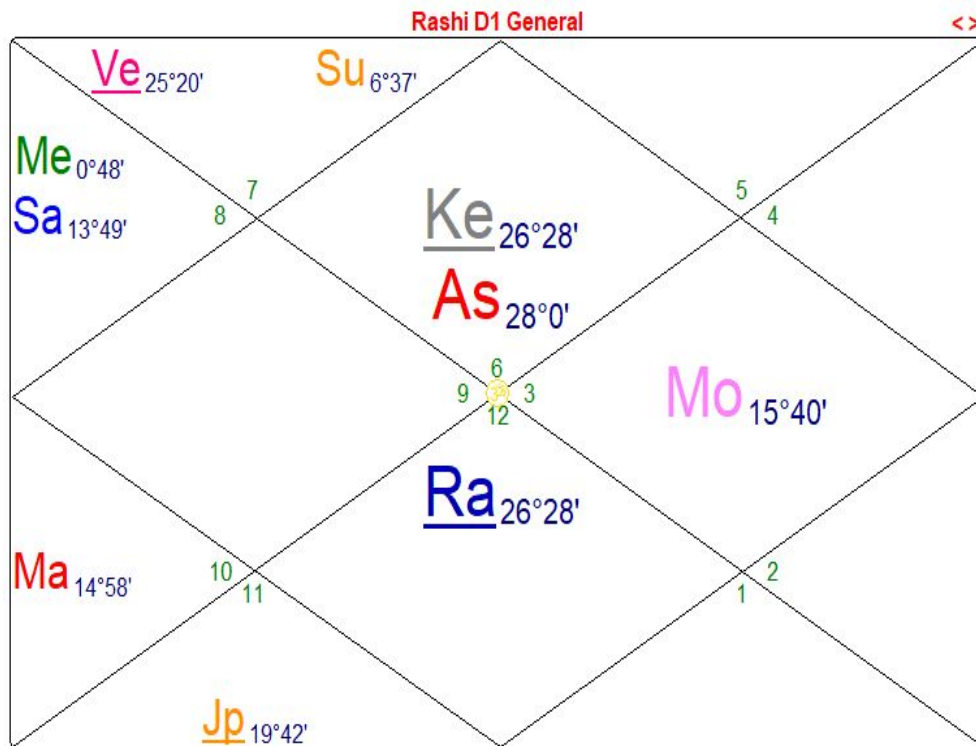
Number of Houses Away - Counting starts inclusive.

Auspicious position if Kendra (1,4,7,10) or Trikona position (5,9)

Inauspicious position if Dusthana positions (3,6,8,12)

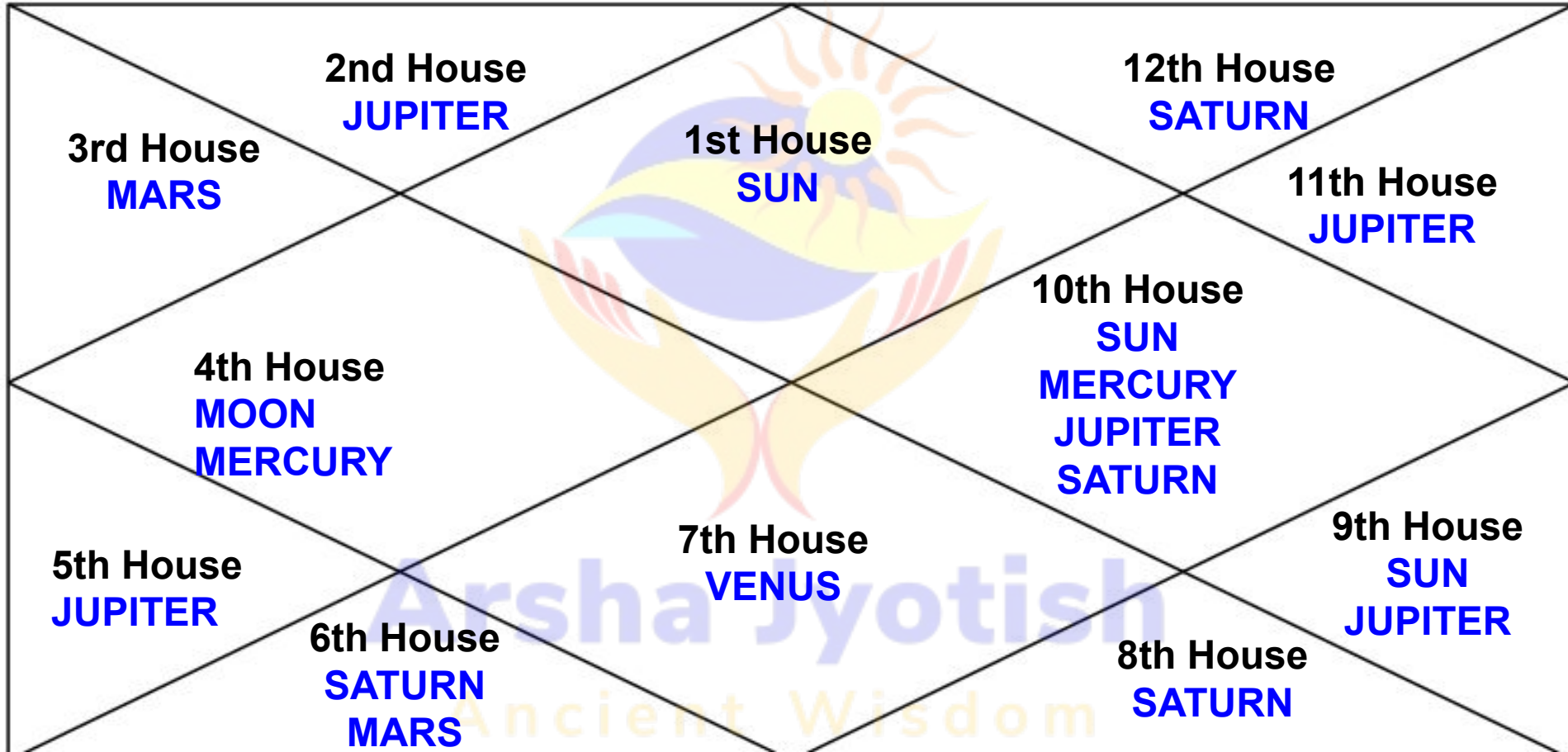

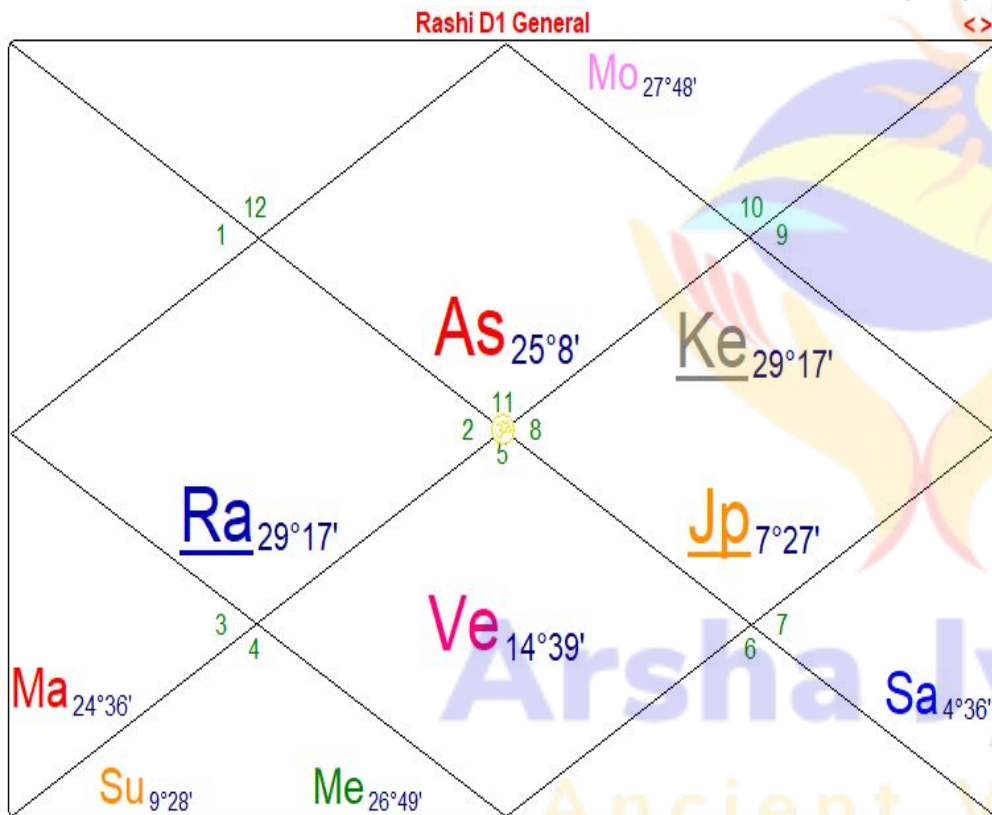

NATURAL Vs. FUNCTIONAL

BENEFIC and MALEFIC

naisargika (नैसर्गिक) - 'natural', 'inborn' or 'innate'. Used to describe a graha's status as a natural benefic or malefic.

tātkālika (तात्कालिक) - 'relating to or fit for a particular moment of time', or 'happening at that time'. This is used to refer to a graha's status as a temporal benefic or malefic, depending upon it's house rulership in the context of a particular lagna.

NATURAL BENEFIC Jupiter, Venus, Mercury, Moon

NATURAL MALEFIC Sun, Saturn, Mars, Rahu, Ketu, Waning Moon, Afflicted Mercury

- **Moon & Mercury** are naturally weak when moon is too close to sun it behaves malefics and Mercury when afflicted behaves malefic.
- **Rahu / Ketu** Natural Malefic, while they are shadow planet they behave differently as per their position, association, and aspect by other planets.
- **Rahu & Ketu** can behave benefics if positioned in the sign of Jupiter and mercury.

FUNCTIONAL BENEFIC OR FUNCTIONAL MALEFIC

Planets behave as benefits and malefics depending on the houses they own. Ownership will vary from one lagna to the others.

There are multiple parashara principles should be applied and understood.

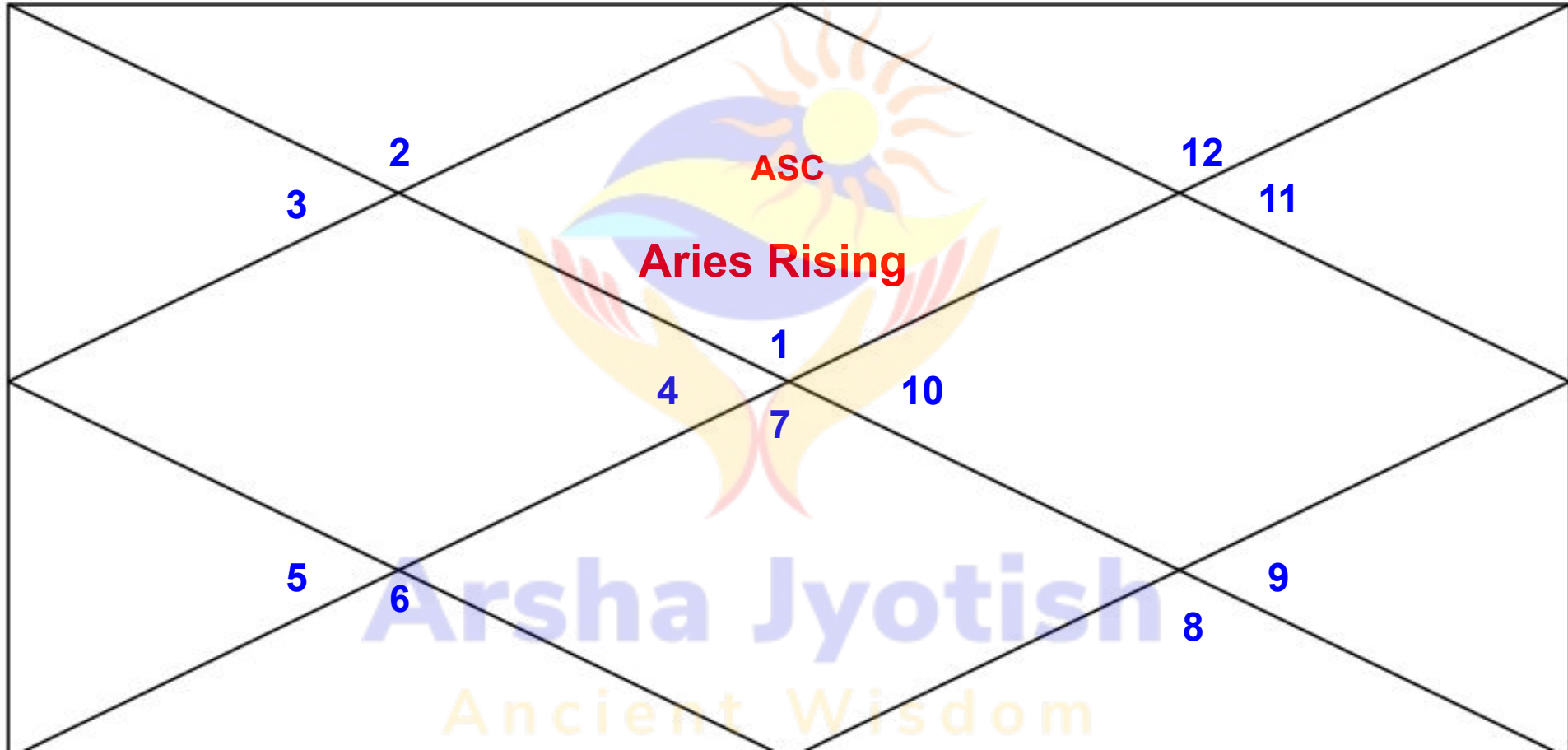
NATURAL ZODIAC

(12 houses, rulership and mutual relationship)

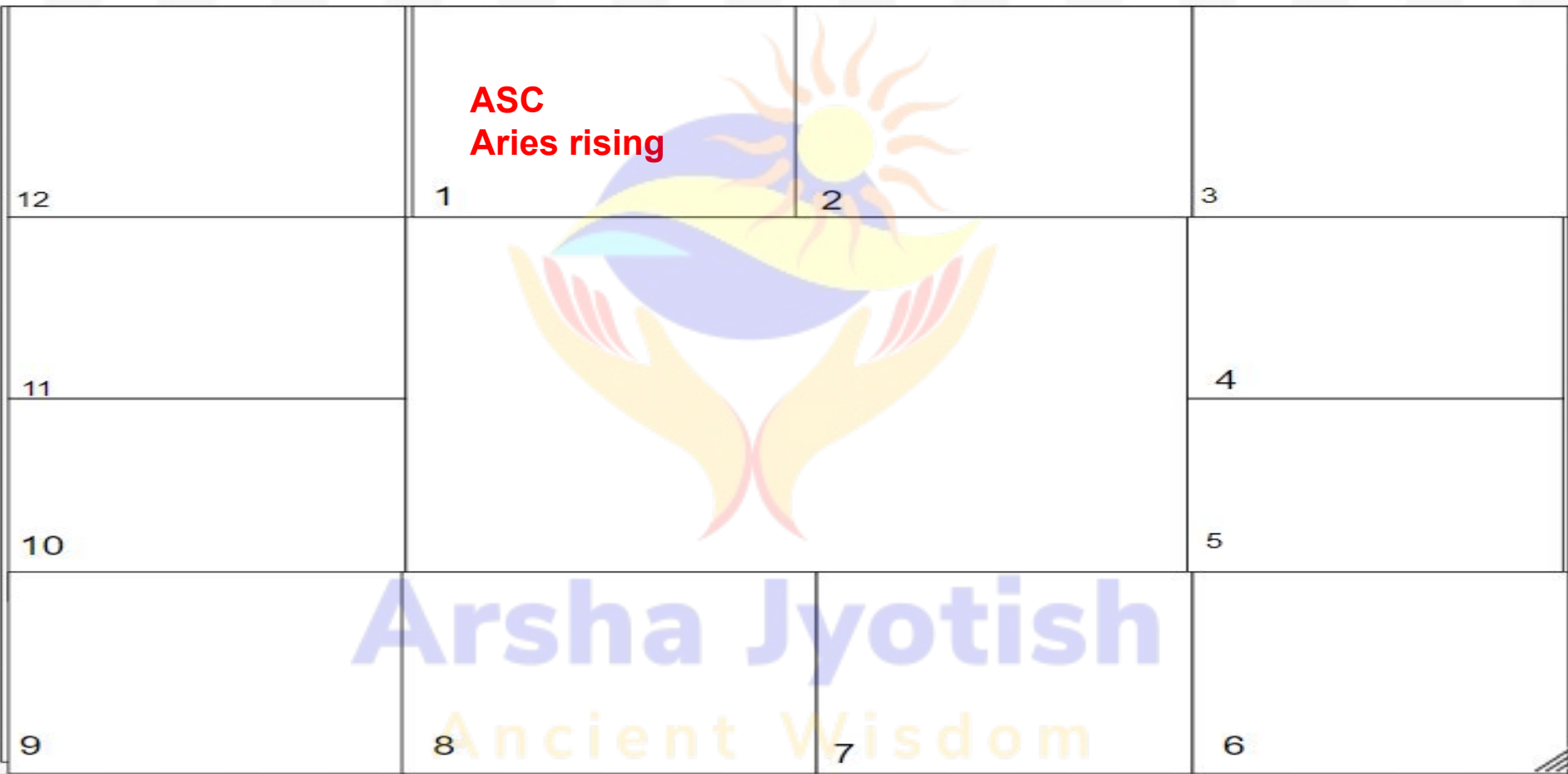
lagna (लग्न) - means to 'tie down'. Often used to mean the ascendant (see *udāya lagna*). This term can also be used to refer to Candra or Sūrya lagna, or other special lagnas.

udāya lagna (उदाय लग्न) - The constellation or star group that is observed on the eastern horizon at the time of birth. Also known as the Ascendant or Rising Sign. ('Udāya' can be translated as 'emerging' or 'coming forward').

SANSKRIT WORDS & ITS MEANINGS

What is prominent meaning of each house? one word

tanu (तनु) - 'body'. refers to the 1st bhāva.

trik (त्रिक्) - refers to the three most negative bhāvas - 6, 8, 12.

ari (अरि) - enemy. refers to the 6th bhāva.

bandhu (बन्धु) - 'relative', 'friend', or 'kinsman'. Refers to the 4th bhāva.

yuvati (युवति) - young woman; girl. Refers to the 7th bhāva, as well as the Moon and Venus as grahas with feminine qualities.

vyaya (व्यय) - 'expenditure', 'dissipation', or 'expense'. Refers to the 12th bhāva.

mokṣa (मोक्ष) - 'liberation', 'release'. A theme of the 12th bhāva.

What is prominent meaning of each house? one word

iṣṭadevatā (इष्टदेवता) - one's chosen deity. A theme of the 5th bhāva.

dussthāna (दुःस्थान) - literally “place of suffering”; negative bhāva (bhāvas 3, 6, 8, 12)

dr̥ṣṭi (द्रष्टि) - glance; aspect

dharma (धर्म) - religious merit, duty, righteousness. A theme of the 9th bhāva.

dhana (धन) - ‘money’. A theme of the 2nd bhāva.

kāraka (कारक) - significator

karma (कर्म) - ‘action’. A theme of the 10th bhāva.

buddhi (बुद्धि) - intellect. Represented by Mercury and the 5th bhāva in Jyotiṣa.

māraka (मारक) - ‘killer’. Refers to the 2nd and 7th bhāvas, as well as their lords - in terms of their death-related themes.

lagna (लग्न) - means to 'tie down'. Often used to mean the ascendant (see *udāya lagna*). This term can also be used to refer to Candra or Sūrya lagna, or other special lagnas.

udāya lagna (उदाय लग्न) - The constellation or star group that is observed on the eastern horizon at the time of birth. Also known as the Ascendant or Rising Sign. ('Udāya' can be translated as 'emerging' or 'coming forward').

sva (स्व) - 'own' or 'one's own'. Often refers to a planet in it's own sign ('sva rāśi')

vyaya (व्यय) - 'expenditure', 'dissipation', or 'expense'. Refers to the 12th bhāva.

bhāva (भाव) - refers to one of the 12 houses of a horoscope. (literally can be translated as 'becoming', 'being', 'manner', 'sentiment', or 'emotion')

What is prominent meaning of each house? one word

puṇya (पुण्य) - holy, pure, meritorious. A theme of the 9th bhava.

pūrva puṇya (पूर्व पुण्य) - former acts of merit. A theme of the 5th bhāva. Pūrva can be translated as 'prior', 'preceding', or 'former'.

putra (पुत्र) - 'son' or 'child'. A theme of the 5th bhāva.

randhra (रन्ध्र) - 'cavity', 'hole'. Refers to the 8th bhāva.

sahaja (सहज) - 'born or produced together'. Refers to the 3rd bhāva as it relates to siblings.

sukha (सुख) - happiness, joy, pleasure or delight. A theme of the 4th bhāva.

upacaya (उपचय) - improvement bhāvas - 3, 6, 10, 11. ('increase' or 'growth')

viveka (विवेक) - wisdom, right judgement, faculty of distinguishing and classifying things according to their real properties. A theme of the 5th bhāva.
