What is Zodiac, Ecliptic and Nakshatra?



The zodiac is a band 18° wide and placed obliquely to the equator. It is divided into twelve equal parts called Rashis or twenty-seven equal parts called Nakshatras. The ecliptic passes through the centre of this band.

Ecliptic – the imaginary circle formed by extending indefinitely the equatorial plane

Zodiac- the imaginary band approximately 9 degree angular distance on either side of the Ecliptic

Constellation Division – 27 divisions of the Zodiac, each of 13 degree 20 minutes

Sign Division – 12 divisions of the Zodiac, each of 30 degree

Nakṣatra (नक्षत्र, “star” or “constellation”) is actually the lunar mansion.
Twenty-seven *nakṣatras* (*nakṣatras* from Aśvini to Revatī)

A **nakshatra (27)** is a lunar mansion or star cluster.
It determine various aspects of a person's life, including their temperament,
career, and relationships.

The **starting point** for the nakshatras is the point on the ecliptic directly opposite
to the star Spica called **Chitrā** in Sanskrit.
It is called Meshadi or the “**start of Aries**”.

The **number of nakshatras** reflects the number of days in a sidereal month
(modern value: 27.32 days).

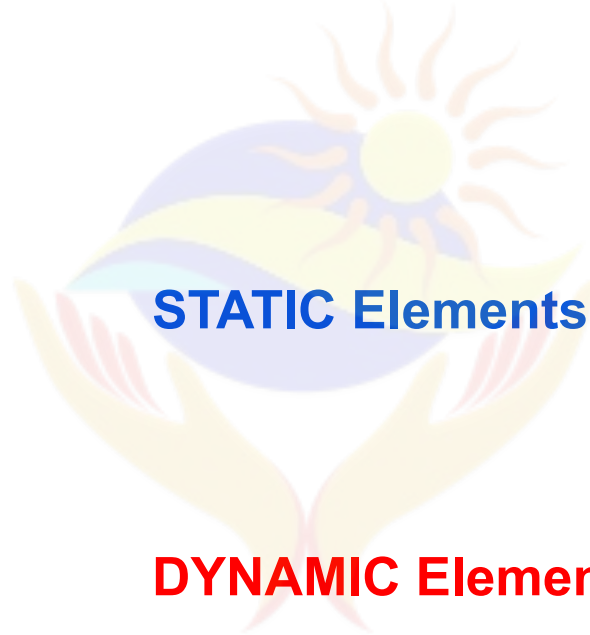

There are numerous Dasa systems advocated by sage Parashara.

The two very widely used Dasas are:

1. The **Vimsottari Dasa**, with a cycle of **120 years**; and
2. The **Yogini Dasa**, with a cycle of **36 years**.

The **Vimsottari Dasa** is calculated based on the position of the Moon at the time of birth , so called **Janma Nakshatra**. The 120-year cycle is divided into major periods (Maha Dasas), each ruled by a planet.

1. Each MahaDasa is divided into sub-periods (Bhuktis) ruled by other planets.
2. The *sequence* of MahaDasa starts with the planet of Janma Nakshatra (Nakshatra Moon is into at birth).
